Uses of CAN (Present Simple)

1. ability or possibility
- I can swim.

2. permission
- You can use my pen.

CAN + VERB * *Base form of the infinitive

He can speak English. ✓

He can speaks English. ✗ No S

He can to speak English. ✗ No TO

QUESTIONS

+ Affirmative They **can** speak Spanish.

? Question **Can** they speak Spanish?

Short Answer Yes, they can. / No, they can't.

CONTRACTION

can't = cannot

He *can't* sing.
= He *cannot* sing.
