1. ability or possibility
- I can swim.

2. permission
- You can use my pen.

CAN + VERB * * Base form of the infinitive
He can speak English. ✓
He can speaks English. ✗ No S
He can to speak English. ✗ No TO

SINGULAR	<div>I can speak English.</div> <div>You can ride a bike.</div> <div>He can drive a car.</div> <div>She can play the guitar.</div> <div>It can swim.</div>	<div>I can't speak French.</div> <div>You can't ride a horse.</div> <div>He can't drive a truck.</div> <div>She can't play the piano.</div> <div>It can't fly.</div>
